
Warm up without the wait or waste

Administered by the U.S. Green Council, LEED breaks down your home's sustainability based on categories like your location, water efficiency, and environmental quality. LEED homes use less energy and water, maximize fresh air, and minimize your exposure to airborne toxins and pollutants. On average, certified homes use 20 to 30% less energy than non-green homes, with some homes saving up to 60%.
